NEW DATES FOR LEAGUE CUP FINALS

THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WILL BE ON MONDAY JUNE the 8th

Details will be circulated later including the venue as it may not be the Rugby Club.

Forms on which clubs can notify their teams for next season will be posted in May for return by June 5th. All clubs must be represented at the AGM.

We have now been offered the use of Valley Parade on Saturday and Sunday the 16th and 17th of May for our League Cup Finals.

We are planning to stage the under 11, 16, 14 games on the Saturday together with the final of the Phoenix Trophies Cup for under 13 teams. On the Sunday we shall play the under 12, 15, 13 finals and the final of the Presidents Trophy for under 15 teams.

Games on both days will commence at 10.00.am and will be finished about 4.00.pm. Admission will be £3 for adults and £1 for children at school and senior citizens. Entry covers all games on that day.

All successful semi-finalists have been given full details of the arrangements.

Under 17 teams receive 14 trophies in line with the different rules for that age.

Admission to the hall is free but we run a raffle to offset the costs of hiring the hall.
